Provision of Google CloudTM Connection via SINET - To Support Fast and Secure Cloud Access by SINET Subscribing Institutions -

TOKAI Communications Corporation (Headquarters: Aoi-ku, Shizuoka-shi, Shizuoka Prefecture; President and Representative Director: Yasuhiro Fukuda; hereinafter the "Company") today announced the provision of a closed-network connection line through which universities, research institutions and other customers using the academic information network SINET (Science Information NETwork, hereinafter "SINET"), constructed and operated by the National Institute of Informatics, Inter-University Research Institute Corporation Research Organization of Information and Systems, can connect to Google (TM)'s enterprise-grade cloud service "Google Cloud" via SINET.


1. Background

Against a background of widespread cloud adoption, the Company is actively pursuing connections with many major cloud services and focusing on planning and developing communication services that can flexibly accommodate the various usage scenarios of customers. The Company is also leveraging the technology and expertise it has built up over many years as a system integrator to provide a one-stop service spanning all processes from consulting on cloud adoption to design, construction, monitoring, and operation.

The Company is now providing the "GCP connection service", which uses its carrier and enterprise telecommunications service "BroadLine" to connect to Google Cloud, one of the cloud service providers in SINET. As a result, SINET subscribing institutions can now use Google Cloud quickly and securely via SINET without arranging a new leased line.

2. Overview of connection provided

The Company has set up connection points between SINET and Google Cloud in two geographically separate locations, Tokyo and Osaka, and connected with a wideband closed-network line at each connection point. The Company will build an individual virtual network within this closed-network line with a configuration suitable for each university, research institution or other user, and realize a secure and stable closed-network connection to Google Cloud via SINET. * The Company plans to continue providing the connection for SINET6 as well.



3. Future initiatives

The Company will contribute to the promotion of education and research activities by supporting the further utilization of the cloud and improvement of the connection quality of SINET subscribing institutions based on service collaboration with Google Cloud.
